

Instructions

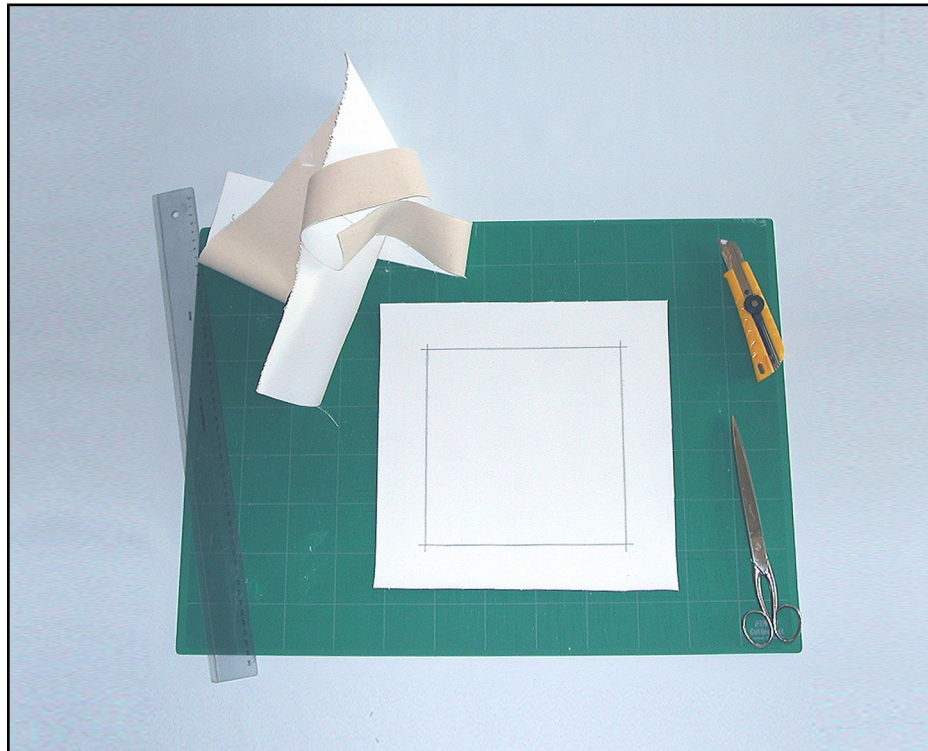
1 Using the straight edge and craft knife trim away the print border leaving just the image. You may wish to save the border since this can be used as a test piece during a later step.

2 Place the print on the centre of the canvas and align the edges with the warp and weft of the canvas weave.

3 Using the pencil lightly draw around the edges of the image, marking its outline onto the canvas.

4 Next, remove the image and draw a 6.25 cm (2.5 in) border all round the image outline. The width of this border will be enough for mounting the canvas to a stretcher. If you plan to mount the canvas onto a thicker backing, such as art foam board, then an additional width allowance may need to be made.

Cut off the excess canvas leaving just the pencil outline of the image. The canvas is now ready to receive the print image layer.
